SUBJECT / TOPIC	CONTENT
ENGLISH	<p>We shall be studying the new National Curriculum in speaking and listening, reading and writing. The children have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report.</p> <p>Within the reading strand, our focus will be on making predictions from details given in a text. We will be looking at clues to help us make sensible judgements about what could happen in a story.</p> <p>In writing we will be focussing on creating characters and settings for story writing. MATHEMATICS	<p>We shall be studying the new National Curriculum.</p> <p>This term our number work will focus on multiplying and dividing.</p> <p>We will also focus upon data handling.</p> <p>The children have individual targets in order to progress.
