YEAR 3 & 4**

SUBJECT / TOPIC	CONTENT
ENGLISH	<p>We shall be studying the new National Curriculum in speaking and listening, reading and writing. The children have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report.</p> <p>Within the reading strand, our focus will be on recognising different types of poetry and performing them with feeling and intonation.</p> <p>Click here for a link to lots of different types of poetry.</p> <p>In writing we will be expanding our range of sentence structures by using clauses in different ways. This will also link to speaking and listening.</p> <p>The children will continue to work on the development of a fluent, cursive style of handwriting.</p>
MATHEMATICS	<p>We shall be studying the new National Curriculum.</p> <p>This term our number work will focus on fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions and learning how to order and compare them.</p> <p>Click here for a useful website for fractions.</p> <p>We will also focus upon area and perimeter. We will learn about how to find the area by counting and how to measure the perimeter.</p> <p>Click here for further details about area and perimeter.</p> <p>The children have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report.</p> <p>We will consolidate the understanding of concepts of time and money and continue to work on mental mathematics skills such as multiplication tables and number bonds.</p>
SCIENCE	<p>We shall be studying the new National Curriculum. We will finish studying Rocks (see Spring term) then focus on Electricity. We will learn about circuits and how electricity works. The children have individual targets in order to progress.</p> <p>Click here for information about electricity.</p> <p>In Computing we will be studying Programming. They will learn about algorithms and giving precise instructions.</p> <p>Click here for more information about programming.</p>
THE ARTS	<p>In Art we will make sculptures about our world and beyond. We will take inspiration from other sculptures.</p> <p>Click here to view ideas from the Yorkshire Sculpture Park.</p> <p>In Music we will be continuing to learn how to play the trumpet whilst learning to read and perform using notated music. We will also be learning, rehearsing and performing songs from the shows.</p>





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HUMANITIES	We will study Topographical Features of the UK . The East Riding is rich in geographical features such as Spurn Point and Bempton Cliffs. Click here for examples of how topographical features are mapped.
PHYSICAL EDUCATION	We will be developing and improving our athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day. We practise sprinting, throwing a javelin and a standing long jump.
RE/PSHCE	<p>In R.E. we will study Encounters. We will learn about special places and why people visit them. We will be thinking about the places that are special to us as well as other people. Click here for useful information about different religions and places that are special for them.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be investigating dreams and goals. We will think about our own personal aspirations and how we can work to achieve them. We will also learn about how other people have achieved their dreams.</p>
TERMLY COMPETITIONS	Throughout the term we will compete in athletics lessons leading up to Sports Day where all children will compete in a variety of events. See our website for videos of previous years. Each week all children compete in a mathematics challenge based on time questions. A multiplication tables competition also takes place at the end of term. The annual competition calendar culminates in our Graduate Award winners taking part in University Challenge.
