SUBJECT / TOPIC	CONTENT
ENGLISH	<ul> <li>We shall be studying the National Curriculum in speaking and listening, reading and writing. The children will have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report. The children will continue to work on the development of a fluent, cursive writing style.</li> <li>Within the reading strand, our focus will be poetry, focusing in particular on imagery, and improving our inference and deduction skills.</li> <li>We shall also study Greek Myths and Legends. In writing, we shall focus on persuasive techniques.</li> </ul>
MATHEMATICS	<ul> <li>We shall be studying the National Curriculum. Arithmetic and its application will be given a high priority. The children will have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report. We shall be looking in particular at 2D and 3D shapes and their properties; and at larger numbers up to ten million (10 000 000)</li> <li>The children will also continue to work on their Passports, which check knowledge and understanding of multiplication tables.</li> </ul>
SCIENCE	<ul> <li>We shall be studying the National Curriculum. The children will have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report.</li> <li>The main topics will be Materials and Forces.</li> <li>Our school Meadow will be used for research as much as the season allows. In Computing, we shall focus on animation.</li> </ul>
THE ARTS	<ul> <li>In Art we shall be developing our pencil skills to create sketches and drawings of buildings, making links to our Ancient Greece studies.</li> <li>In DT we shall be improving our textile skills to create festive decorations for the School Hall.</li> <li>In Music, we shall be preparing for our annual X-Factor competition, Harvest and Christmas.</li> </ul>
HUMANITIES	We shall be studying how Ancient Greek culture has affected British history, and its continued influence on the western world. We shall complete some appropriate mapping work.







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PHYSICAL EDUCATION	We shall be working on dance, where we shall bring Greek myths to life! We shall continue to play competitive games, applying basic principles of attacking and defending.
