

SUMMER TERM 2018 CURRICULUM STATEMENT YEAR 5 & 6

SUBJECT / TOPIC	CONTENT
ENGLISH	We shall be studying the National Curriculum in speaking and listening, reading and writing. The children will have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report. The children will continue to work on the development of a fluent, cursive writing style. Within the reading strand, our focus will be on stories from other cultures, traditions and time periods. In writing, we shall focus on appropriate use of complex punctuation and grammar.
MATHEMATICS	We shall be studying the National Curriculum. Arithmetic and its application will be given a high priority. The children will have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report. We shall be looking in particular at using and applying our mathematical skills culminating in our Young Apprentice competition. The children will also continue to work on their Passports, which check knowledge and understanding of multiplication tables.
SCIENCE	We shall be studying the National Curriculum. The children will have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report. The main topics will be Living Things and Their Habitats. Our school Meadow will be used for research as much as the season allows. In Computing, we shall focus on using algorithms and coding.
THE ARTS	In Art we shall be developing our sculpting skills. In Music, we shall be looking at songs from around the world as well as at traditional British anthems.
HUMANITIES	In Geography, we will be describing and understanding key aspects of physical geography such as rivers and mountains. We will continue to develop our mapping skills.
PHYSICAL EDUCATION	We shall be working on gymnastics, including balance and counter-balance. We shall continue to play competitive striking and fielding team games.









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RE/PSHCE	In RE we shall be studying Justice and Freedom, considering what makes something fair. In PSHE we shall be reflecting upon Changes.
TERMLY COMPETITIONS	This term is our annual Young Apprentice competition. We shall also be holding our yearly Sports Day event as well as our athletics competition.
