	This term, in reading we will be teaching reading weekly during guided sessions. This is where an objective is taught to a group during a session. In addition to this we will hear the children read individually at least twice a week. We also encourage the children to read as much as they can in their own time. This can be any book they want not just their home school reading book. We do run 3 reading clubs a week where the children can read for some of their lunchtime. The children will practise their reading through a variety of activities, including comprehension tasks, phonic games and reading stories to each other. Year 1 children will continue to be taught phonics following the letters and sounds scheme and building on what they have learnt in foundation stage. The year 2 children will be taught spelling and grammar following the Oxford Owl Scheme.
