YEAR 3 & 4

SUBJECT / TOPIC	CONTENT
ENGLISH	We shall be studying the new National Curriculum in speaking and listening, reading and writing. The children have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report.
	Within the reading strand, our focus will be on how to <u>infer information</u> from different text types and focussing on <u>sentence structure in writing</u> . This will also link to speaking and listening.
