YEAR 5 & 6

SUBJECT / TOPIC	CONTENT
ENGLISH	We shall be studying the new National Curriculum in speaking and listening, reading and writing. The children have individual targets in order to progress. You will receive a written copy and review of these in your child's termly report.
	Within the reading strand, our focus will be poetry, focusing in
	particular on imagery, and improving our inference and deduction

	We shall also study Greek Myths and Legends. Click <u>here</u> to listen to some examples of these.
	In writing, we shall focus on persuasive techniques. Speaking and listening will complement this by developing narrative poetry recitation and by preparing and delivering speeches in a competition to be judged by The Rotary Club. The children will continue to work on the development of a fluent, cursive style of handwriting.
MATHS	We shall be studying the new National Curriculum. Arithmetic will be given a high priority along with the application of this. The children will all be taught to mastery level in order to progress.
	We shall be looking in particular at larger numbers up to ten million (10 000 000) and the four operations. The children will also continue to work on their multiplication tables, using an online resource both at home and school.
