Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for your patience and understanding regarding the current situation of industrial action. Unfortunately, I must inform you that the same classes that closed yesterday will have to be closed next Tuesday (2ndMay) also. These classes are: F/1W, 3/4R, 5/6N and 5/6F.

All other classes will be open, and all other children should attend as normal. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and will not be in school due to strike action, please contact the office as soon as possible on Tuesday morning to arrange to collect a free school packed lunch if you would like one. Once again, I apologise for the inconvenience that this will undoubtedly cause you. I sincerely hope that there will be a resolution very soon.

We are planning to hold Sports Mornings on the school field for the children on the final week of this half term. You are warmly invited to attend these and cheer your children on! As always, these occasions are very dependent on the weather. The arrangements are as follows:

EYFS and Key Stage 1 (FS, F/1W, 1/2J and 1/2W) – Tuesday 23^{rd} May at 10am **OR** (if the weather is poor on that day) Thursday 25^{th} May at 10am. The sports/races will last around an hour.

Key Stage 2 (3/4R, 3/4M, 5/6F, 5/6N, 5/6H) – Wednesday 24^{th} May at 10am **OR** (if the weather is poor on that day) Friday 26^{th} May at 10am. The sports/races will last around an hour.

I shall remind you of these arrangements a little nearer the time.
