Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for doing your best to get the children to school promptly at 8.50am every morning. I would like to remind you that late arrivals may have to wait at the intercom gate for quite some time as our reduced office staff is usually busy beyond 8.50am looking after children who have already arrived in school. You may have also noticed that the gate is being locked promptly at 8.55am every morning. This is to ensure the safety of all of the children who have arrived into school on time.
